

Board Goals for 2015-2016:

Increase student achievement in the areas of reading, writing and science.

- Increase percent of students meeting projected growth targets by at least 5% for K-2, based on Reading MAP results from fall to spring.
- Increase percent of students meeting projected growth target by at least 5% for 6th – 10th grade, based on Science MAP results from fall to spring.
- Compare third grade language arts outcomes with state outcomes related to proficient student percentages. Improve trend outcomes for our district, when compared to the percent of students proficient in the state.
- Train all teachers on the RTI process and develop determined “non-negotiables” for each building.
- Establish baseline results on student placement after high school.

Increase access and use of technology to drive instruction.

- Complete transfer to the new server and online Odyssey options.
- Develop a guest access on a secure network.
- Increase the number of mobile devices available for students.
- Train teachers to use and access technology to maximize learning.

Upgrade facilities.

- Research options that maximize outcomes, while minimizing costs.
- Prioritize needs based on past needs assessments completed.

Provide transparency around operations through communication with the community.

- Hold community “state of the school” talks to share budgeting information.
- Analyze parent input from the school improvement process to look for additional ways to share information with stakeholders.
- Use the media and technology to provide information in a variety of ways.
